



INSTRUCTIONS AND MISCELLANEOUS DETAILS

- We recognize the sensitive issue that some won't attend a service without masks being required, while others won't attend a service if masks are required ... as per the official CDC Guidelines for Houses of Worship, facemask use is strongly encouraged, but not mandated. - Offering plates will not be passed, but placed in by entrances for people to leave tithes and offerings. Online giving is also encouraged.
